**Arizona Motorcycle Safety Advisory Council (AMSAC)
Meeting Minutes
June 15, 2016**

A public meeting of the Arizona Motorcycle Safety Advisory Council (AMSAC) was convened on Tuesday, March 8, 2016 at 1700 West Washington Street, Executive Tower, Suite 430, Phoenix, Arizona, 85007, in the Governor's Office of Highway Safety Conference Room.

CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL:

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Joseph Klima, AMSAC Chairman, at 10:35 a.m.

MEETING MINUTES:

Motion by Mr. Joseph Klima, AMSAC Chairman, to approve the minutes from March 8 2016. Second motion by Lt. Colonel Timothy Chung, Vice Chairman. All in favor, minutes approved by Mr. Joseph Klima.

WELCOME & UPDATE & LEGISLATIVE ISSUES:

GOHS Director Alberto Gutier advised that the bill SB1359; which would have extended the AMSAC Council for another eight years has not passed.

BUDGET UPDATE:

GOHS Director Alberto Gutier advised the council of the current budget and balance.

STOCK ITEMS INVENTORY:

GOHS Director Alberto Gutier advised AMSAC Council that he is working on securing funding for items such as keychains, pencils, brochures for example, to pass out at events.

AMSAF SCHOLARSHIP REQUEST

GOHS Director Alberto Gutier recommended the best use of the \$250,000.00 in the budget is to have all funding go to the Arizona Motorcycle Safety & Awareness Foundation for scholarships. The scholarships save more lives by giving training to motorcycle drivers. Mr. Joseph Klima, AMSAC Chairman made the motion that 100% of all funds go to scholarships. Second motion by Lt. Colonel Timothy Chung, Vice Chairman. All in favor, motion approved by Mr. Joseph Klima.
