**Meeting Minutes**

**CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL:**

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Dick Studdard, AMSAC Chairman, at 10:35 a.m.

**WELCOME & UPDATE & LEGISLATIVE ISSUES:**

GOHS Director Alberto Gutier provided updates on legislative bills.

Mr. Gutier provided AMSAC Council with Arizona fatal statistics; which have increased 8-10% from last year.

**BUDGET UPDATE:**

GOHS Director Alberto Gutier provided the *FY 2013 Motorcycle Safety Fund Budget* hand-out to the AMSAC Members. Director Gutier reviewed the media expenditure with the AMSAC Council.

**STOCK ITEMS INVENTORY:**

Mr. Dick Studdard, AMSAC Chairman discusses a follow up letter be completed by the requestor for accountability of the items and the inventory form be accessible on the GOHS website. Director Gutier agrees it will help with inventory control.

GOHS Director Alberto Gutier asked the Board Members to review the tri-folds for suggestions and feedback prior to printing more.

Mr. Dick Studdard, AMSAC Chairman discusses the availability of the Motorcycle Safety Manuals to be linked on the GOHS website, Director Gutier noted that the AMSAC Council could submit a funding request for additional manuals to be printed from the Motor Vehicle Division.

AMSAC Chairman Dick Studdard recommended skipping the Advertisement agenda item due to it being discussed during the budget update.

**MOTORCYCLE RIDER EDUCATION RECOMMENDATIONS:**

Mr. Dick Studdard, AMSAC Chairman, discussed the current monitoring and enforcement issues of Motorcycle Rider Training Schools. Mr. Gutier suggested an open discussion with other groups to further discuss the training requirements, Mick Degn motioned and Don Borland seconded, all in favor.
