**I. Call to Order and Roll Call**

**II. Minutes of the May 12, 2014 Meeting**

Minutes of the May 12, 2014 meeting were motioned for approval by Alberto Gutier, Linda Gray seconded and all in favor.

**III. Grant Agreement Considerations- Alberto Gutier, GOHS Staffing Agency**

- Arizona Department of Public Safety – Proposal #00193, Alberto Gutier motioned to approve \$200,000.00 for DUI Enforcement Overtime Statewide, Bradley Beauchamp seconded, Robert Halliday abstained from voting and all others in favor.
- Glendale Police Department- Proposal #00191, Alberto Gutier motioned to approve \$40,325.00 for the innovative "Know Your Limit" program, Stacey Stanton seconded, Robert Walecki abstained from voting and all others in favor.

- Phoenix Police Department- Proposal #00192, Alberto Gutier motioned to approve \$50,000.00 for DUI Enforcement Overtime, Bradley Beauchamp seconded and all in favor. Lieutenant Scott Sowerwine, Sergeant Carl Clovis and Detective Joe Bianchi from Phoenix Police Department were present for the Council and available to answer any questions.
- Pinetop-Lakeside Police Department- Proposal #00196, Alberto Gutier motioned to approve \$10,000.00 for the Innovative DUI Enforcement program, Stacey Stanton seconded and all in favor.
- Tucson Police Department- Proposal #00194, #00195 and #00197, Alberto motioned to approve \$133,000.00 for DUI Enforcement, \$25,000.00 for DUI Testimony Training and \$75,000.00 for the innovative “Know Your Limit” program with a total of \$233,000.00, Stacey Stanton seconded and all in favor.
- DUIAC Grant Manager Phil Corbell requested, and was granted the Council’s concurrence that the decision to fund grants up-front or on a reimbursement basis be left to the Governor’s Highway Safety Representative, Alberto Gutier, based on the availability of DUI Abatement Funds.
